

APPLYING TODAY’S GOSPEL

In today’s Gospel Jesus presents a strange story about a royal wedding. The last servants who traveled the roads to bring in guests invited anyone they could find, good and bad alike; people who would have never expected an invitation. These gentiles responded to their invitation with joy, and the wedding feast was filled with guests.

These last servants who traveled the roads were the apostles and the missionaries of the Church. The king told his servants to “go”, the same word used later in Matthews Gospel when Jesus tells His disciples to “go” and make disciples of all nations. They traveled beyond Jerusalem into Gentile lands; to Europe, Asia, Africa and eventually to America and Australia. And they are still going out, these missionaries, priests, sisters and laypeople, suffering hardship as Paul, in the second reading, told us he did, inviting men and women into the kingdom of God. And all of us in different ways are part of that mission of spreading the Gospel.

The beauty of this parable is that it presents the kingdom of God as a wedding banquet, highly desirable and attractive. Moreover, the Lord freely invites us to be guests. We do not have to be worthy: we couldn’t be worthy of God’s invitation. God invites both the good and the bad; God wants us all to be there. But, why was an unfortunate man thrown out for not wearing a wedding garment? At baptism a white garment is put on; we are clothed in Christ. It is a salutary reminder that we are called to grow into the likeness of Christ we have put on, and live the Gospel life.

APLICANDO EL EVANGELIO DE HOY

En el Evangelio de hoy, Jesús presenta una extraña historia acerca de una boda real. Los últimos sirvientes que recorrieron los caminos para traer los invitados, invitaron a todos los que pudieron encontrar, buenos y malos por igual; gente que nunca hubiera esperado una invitación. Estos no judíos respondieron a su invitación con alegría, y la fiesta de bodas se llenó de invitados.

Estos últimos siervos que recorrieron los caminos fueron los apóstoles y los misioneros de la Iglesia. El rey le dijo a sus sirvientes que "fueran", lo mismo que en el Evangelio de Mateo cuando Jesús les dice a Sus discípulos que "vayan" y hagan discípulos de todas las naciones. Viajaron más allá de Jerusalén en tierras no judías; a Europa, Asia, África y eventualmente a América y Australia. Y estos misioneros, sacerdotes, hermanas y laicos, sufriendo penurias como Pablo, en la segunda lectura, nos dijeron que lo hacían, invitando a hombres y mujeres al reino de Dios. Y todos nosotros de diferentes maneras formamos parte de esa misión de difundir el Evangelio.

La belleza de esta parábola es que presenta el reino de Dios como un banquete de bodas, altamente deseable y atractivo. Además, el Señor nos invita libremente a ser huéspedes. No tenemos que ser dignos: no podríamos ser dignos de la invitación de Dios. Dios invita tanto al bien como al mal; Dios quiere que todos estén allí. Pero, ¿por qué un hombre desafortunado fue echado por no usar una prenda de boda? En el bautismo se pone una prenda blanca; estamos vestidos en Cristo. Es un recuerdo que estamos llamados a crecer en la semejanza de Cristo que nos hemos puesto y a vivir la vida del Evangelio.
